INSTRUCTIONS TO TEACHERS

1. The contest is to be written on **Monday, May 25, 2020**. The exam should be in a sealed envelope, to be opened in the presence of the candidates just before the contest is written.
2. The BCCO is a Multiple Choice (90 min.) examination. The “University of Ottawa Bubble Sheets” provided should be used to answer the contest.
3. The Instructions to Students, and the Periodic Table/Data sheet may be shown to candidates anytime before the contest. The Periodic Table/Data sheet may be used for all parts of the contest, and non-programmable calculators are allowed.
4. There is no penalty for incorrect answers. Questions and answers are to be collected after 90 minutes.
5. **Make sure that your name, school’s name and e-mail address are clearly written on the return envelope.**
6. **Make sure student’s names are written on the answer sheet.**
7. Specify your school code to your students (Included below): 3-letter code for province/territory, 3-digit number for region/district, 3-digit number for school, and 1-digit number for grade level (9 for Grade 9, 0 for Grade 10, 1 for Grade 11...). This code will always remain the same for your school.
